

ELECTION COMMISSION OF SRHUAA

Directions for Conduct of Election to the Governing Body

In pursuance of the resolution passed by the Governing Body of the **Swami Rama Himalayan University Alumni Association (SRHUAA)** and in terms of Letter Nos. **SRHUAA/2026/20, SRHUAA/2026/22 and SRHUAA/2026/23**, all dated **20.07.2026**, an Election Commission comprising the undersigned was duly constituted for conducting the election of members of the Governing Body of SRHUAA.

The Election Commission, having considered the provisions relating to elections contained in the Trust Deed and the duly approved Rules and Procedures for the Election of Members of the Governing Body of SRHUAA, hereby issues the following directions for the conduct of the forthcoming election:

1. Date of Election

That the election for **six (06)** members of the Governing Body of SRHUAA is proposed to be held on **19th September 2026**. The Governing Body shall notify the date and other relevant details of the election to all eligible alumni/life members latest by **20th August 2026**, through the SRHUAA alumni website, social media platforms, including the official Facebook/WhatsApp groups, or through any other mode as may be deemed appropriate.

2. Proposal and Seconding of Candidates

That any alumnus of SRHUAA may propose the name of an eligible **Life Member** who is willing to contest the election for membership of the Governing Body. Such nomination shall be duly seconded by another eligible alumnus and submitted in the prescribed format annexed hereto as **Annexure 1**.

3. Submission of Nomination

That any eligible Life Member intending to contest the election for any of the **six (06) seats** of the Governing Body shall submit his/her nomination in the prescribed format and shall comply with the **Code of Conduct for the Election**, annexed hereto as **Annexure 2**.

4. Undertaking by Candidate

That every candidate shall furnish, along with his/her nomination, a duly signed undertaking confirming that he/she shall abide by the Code of Conduct applicable to the election. The prescribed format of the undertaking is annexed hereto as **Annexure 3**.


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5. Last Date for Submission of Nomination

That the nomination form, duly completed in the prescribed format and accompanied by the requisite undertaking, shall be submitted to the Election Commission through the SRHUAA alumni website at *alumni@srhu.edu.in* on or before **4th September 2026**. Any nomination received after the prescribed date and time shall be liable to be rejected as time-barred and invalid.

6. Withdrawal of Candidature

That any candidate who has submitted a valid nomination may withdraw his/her candidature by submitting a written notice of withdrawal to the Election Commission on or before **4 PM on 6th of September 2026**. Such withdrawal shall be irrevocable upon acceptance by the Election Commission and the name of the candidate shall thereafter not be included in the final list of candidates or on the ballot/electronic voting system.

7. Scrutiny and Final List of Eligible Candidates

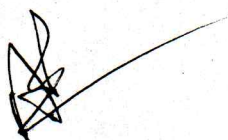
That the Election Commission shall scrutinize the nomination forms and determine the eligibility of the candidates in accordance with the applicable rules and procedures. The list of eligible candidates shall be published/notified on or before **8th September 2026** on the alumni website.

That if any candidate finds that his/her name has been incorrectly spelt, incorrectly recorded or otherwise inaccurately reflected in the list of eligible candidates, he/she may submit a written request to the Election Commission for correction of the name or spelling on or before **11th September 2026**.

That upon being satisfied as to the genuineness and correctness of such request, the Election Commission may make the necessary correction and shall thereafter publish/upload the final list of eligible candidates on the SRHUAA alumni website.

8. Mode of Voting

That the Voting shall be conducted through **secret ballot**, either by physical ballot or through an electronic voting system made available through the SRHUAA alumni website, as may be determined by the Election Commission. Where physical/offline voting is conducted, the same shall take place before the Election Commission at the venue designated and notified by it.



9. Procedure in case of a tie between candidates securing equal votes

That in case it appears that there is a tie or an equality of votes between any candidates at the election and that the addition of a vote would entitle any of those candidates to win, the founder shall decide between them by lot and proceed as if the one on whom the lot then falls had received an additional vote.

10. Declaration of Elected Candidates

That the six (06) candidates securing the highest number of valid votes in the election shall be declared elected as members of the Governing Body of SRHUAA, subject to the applicable provisions of the Trust Deed and the approved Election Rules and Procedures.

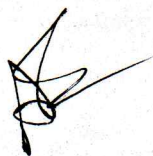
11. Declaration of Election Result

That the Election Commission shall scrutinize and finalize the voting results and shall declare and publish the result of the election on **22nd September 2026** through the SRHUAA alumni website and/or such other mode as may be deemed appropriate.

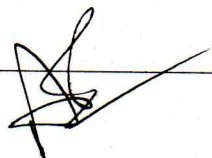

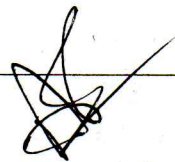

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. **Maintain Integrity and Fairness**
Every candidate shall uphold the highest standards of honesty, integrity, and ethical conduct throughout the election process.
2. **Respect Fellow Candidates**
Candidates shall refrain from making false, defamatory, or derogatory statements against any other candidate. Elections shall be contested in a spirit of mutual respect and healthy competition.
3. **Declaration Regarding Criminal Record**
I do not hold any criminal record, nor have I been convicted by any court of law for any offence involving moral turpitude.
4. **No Undue Influence or Inducement**
Candidates shall not offer gifts, money, hospitality, favours, or any other inducement to influence the votes of alumni members.
5. **Responsible Campaigning**
Campaigning shall be conducted in a dignified and professional manner. Candidates may present their vision, objectives, and credentials without resorting to personal attacks or misinformation.
6. **Compliance with Election Rules**
Candidates shall strictly comply with all election rules, timelines, procedures, and directions issued by the Election Commission/Returning Officer of the Alumni Association.
7. **Appropriate Use of Communication Platforms**
Social media, emails, messaging platforms, and other communication channels shall be used responsibly. Candidates shall not circulate misleading information, fake news, and offensive content, or unauthorized campaign material.
8. **Respect for Institutional Resources**
Candidates shall not use the University's or Alumni Association's official name, logo, facilities, mailing lists, or other institutional resources for campaigning without prior written approval from the competent authority.
9. **Declaration of Fair Election Practices**
I shall not indulge in any corrupt practice, undue influence, bribery, intimidation, dissemination of false information, or any act that may adversely affect the fairness and transparency of the election.
10. **Acceptance of Election Results**
Candidates shall respect the final decision and declared results of the Election Commission and shall not engage in any activity that disrupts the electoral process or the functioning of the Alumni Association.
11. **No Misrepresentation**
Candidates shall provide accurate information regarding their qualifications, alumni status, achievements, and other details submitted during the nomination process. Any false declaration may lead to disqualification.
12. **Promote Unity and Alumni Values**
Candidates shall conduct themselves in a manner that strengthens the reputation, unity, and objectives of the Alumni Association, fostering goodwill and cooperation among all alumni members.
13. **Avoid Conflict of Interest**
Candidates shall disclose any conflict of interest, if applicable, and shall not use their official position or influence in any organization to gain an unfair electoral advantage.
14. **Consequences of Violation**
Any violation of this Code of Conduct may invite disciplinary action, including warning, cancellation of candidature, or any other action deemed appropriate by the Election Commission, whose decision shall be final and binding.

9. I agree to accept the decision of the Election Commission on matters relating to the conduct of the election, subject to the provisions of the applicable Constitution/Bye-laws and Election Rules of the Alumni Association.
